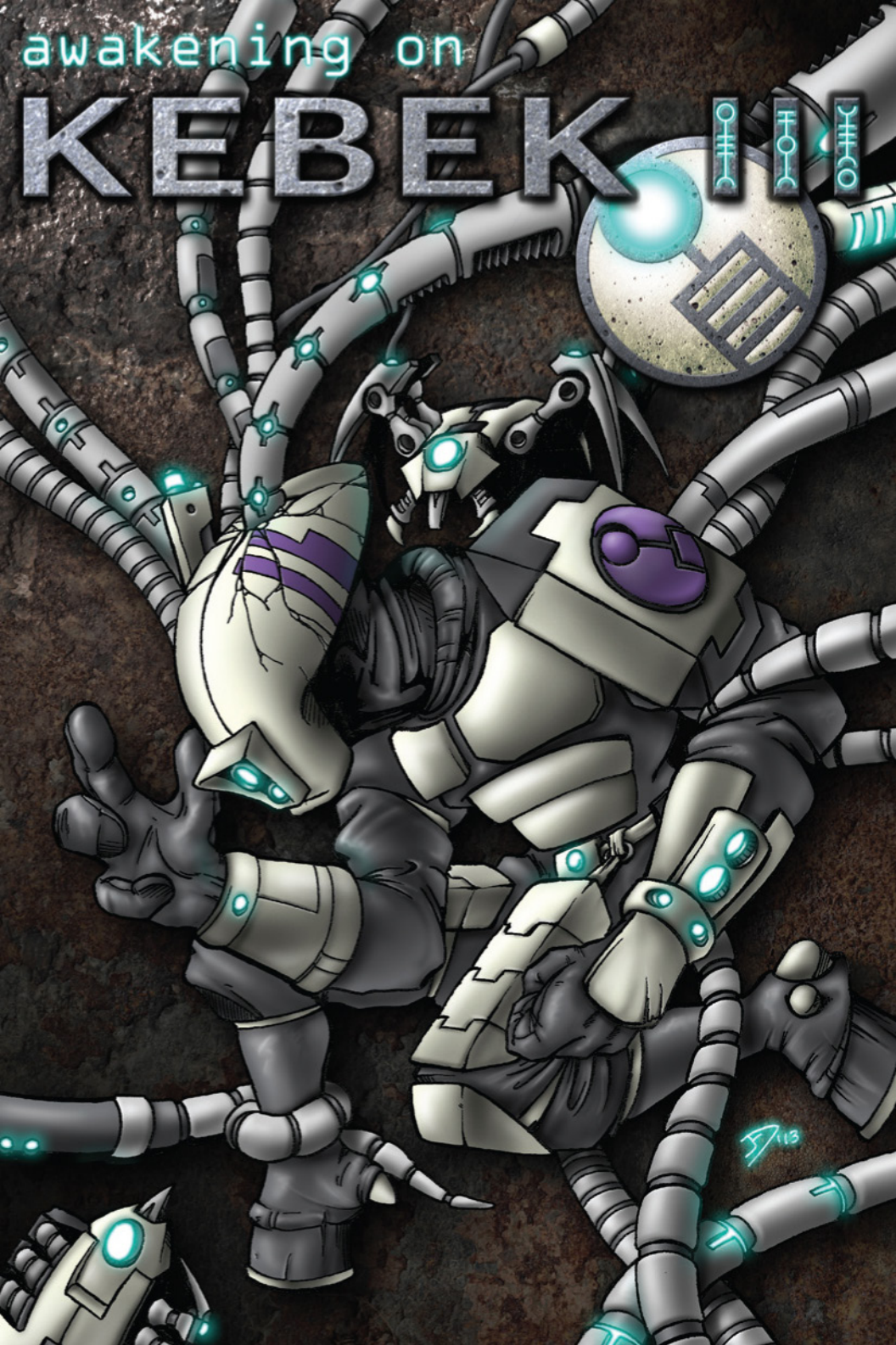

I was defeated utterly.

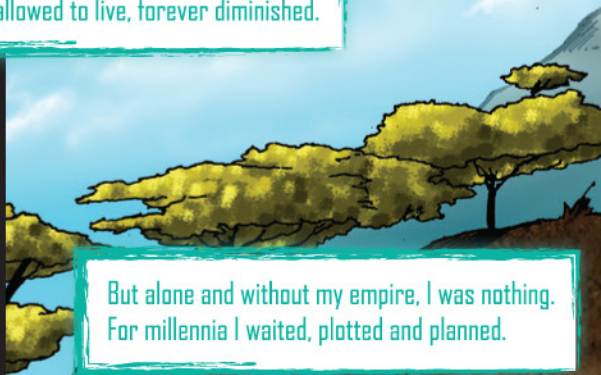


Once the absolute master of a vast and mighty dynasty,

What's with the name 'Kebek' anyways?

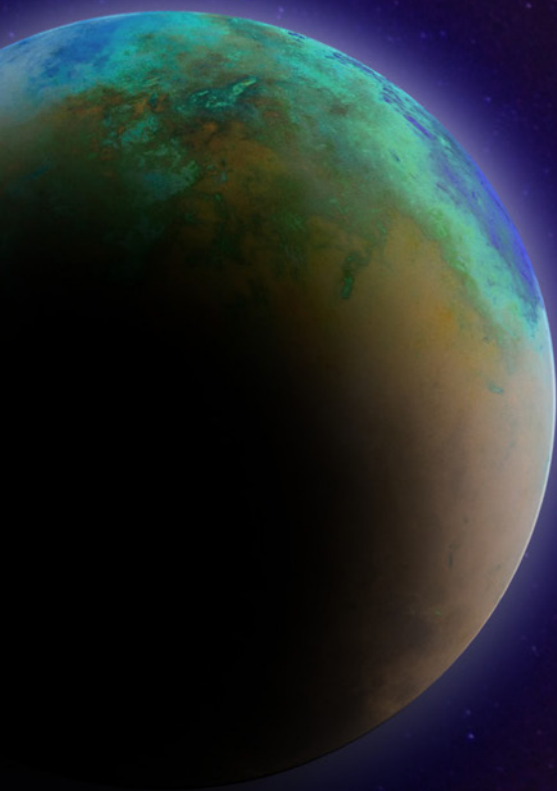
